Taking inspiration from the likes of Tove Lo, Vera Blue, Robyn, Romy, Låpsley, and Maggie Rogers (Just to name a few female powerhouses), Beth has worked hard to create a sound of her own.

Earlier this year Beth spent three months in LA honing her craft and writing new music, before relocating to London. There, she scouted numerous producers to collaborate with who would help bring her ideas to life. Beth teamed up with the incredibly talented Chris Zane, producer, mixer and engineer, known for his work with American pop band Passion Pit and Australian indie arist Eves Karydas. This collaboration has resulted in a sonically rich and emotionally resonant song that you can't help but bop along to.
